

The lotus is our House flower. It is an embodiment of perfection and spirituality.



# Scouts and Guides Club
















# English Literary Club

The Literary Club teaches students about famous personalities who have contributed immensely to the literary world and essentially changed the English language forever.


















#### Yoga Club

It has evolved from single counting, measurement and calculation and the systematic study of shapes and motions of physical objects, through the application of abstractions, imagination and logic, to the broad complex and often abstract discipline we know today.

Greek mathematicians greatly refined the methods and expanded the subject matter of mathematics. The ancient Romans used to apply Mathematics in surveying, structural engineering, mechanical engineering and even arts and crafts. Chinese mathematicians made early contributions including place value system and the first use of negative numbers.

The discipline of mathematics now covers, in addition to more or less standard fields of numbers theory, algebra, geometry, statistics, control theory, knot theory, complexity theory and many more. Some of the famous mathematicians are Aryabhatta, Bhaskara, Bhrama Gupta, Prasanta Chandra MAhalonobis, Shakuntala Devi, Ramanujan and so on.

We are the students of Little Flower High School are very active in participating in various mathematics related competitive exams and Olympiads. We have also conducted various programmes on the occasion of Srinivas Ramanujan's Birth Day, i.e. 22nd December. We have won innumerable prizes at the State Level, National Level and in the Monfort International Olympaid conducted every year we thank our principal Rev. Bro. Dr. A. Anthony Reddy for providing a well equipped Mathematics lab which enables us to learn more concretely while doing activities.

# Robotics Club



# Craft Club



# Music Club


Plato said," Music is a more potent instrument than any other form of education."


Our Music club helps students to develop their vocal and instrumental talents. The students have participated in many internal and external competitions and have won laurels for themselves and the school.

# Lifeline Club







It is our social responsibility as students to bring about a change in the society and we feel Dance is one of the best ways to communicate this message to the society.


