Recipe

Russian salad

Ingredients :-

Boiled and cubed vegetables (carrots,potatos,beans-1cup)
Chopped vegetables (green , red , yellow capsicums ,cucumber , onions) – ½ cup, Mayo – 4 table spoon, Cream – 2 table spoon
Salt and pepper – to taste
Mixed herbs

Method:

take a bowl , add all the vegies
Add mayo , cream , salt & pepper and mixed herbs in it , mix well

It can take a little time for it to expand, but it will happen! If you use an iron, follow the instructions on the Fabric Creations Plus bottle

SPACE NEWS

WONDERS OF SPACE

"When you look at the stars and the galaxy, you feel that you are not just from any particular place of land, but from the solar system." Rightly quoted by Kalpana Chawla, "Space" is not just the blue-black sky we watch everyday and night, it's beyond our imagination, full of mysteries that remain hidden even today. It's also beautiful, mesmerizing, staggering and words aren't enough to describe it. We all know that scientists worked their heart out and are still working with all they have, like technology, knowledge to find and solve mysteries of the space. Now, I'm going to mention a few of them:

- Astronomers spot a small black hole beyond the Milky Way in milestone discovery.
- The astronomers made the discovery using the European Southern Observatory's Very Large Telescope (VLT). The researchers turned the VLT's eyes upon NGC 1888, a cluster nestled in the neighboring Large Magellanic Cloud about 160,000 light-years away from Earth. The researchers observed the stars' motions to find any signs of a ghostly black hole. They found subtle dips in one star's motion. The telltale sign of the black hole that star was orbiting. About 1 black hole with around 11 times the mass of the sun.
- The moon's top layer alone has enough oxygen to sustain 8 billion people for 100,000 years
- In October, the Australian Space Agency and NASA signed a deal to send an Australian-made rover to the moon under the Artemis program, with a goal to collect lunar rocks that could ultimately provide breathable oxygen on the moon. It just isn't in a gaseous form, instead, it's trapped inside regolith — the layer of rock and fine dust that covers the moon's surface. If we could extract oxygen from regolith, there is a chance for human survival on the moon.

Just Go Green, Keep The Planet Clean

Environmental issues are defined as harmful effects to Earth and its natural systems due to the actions of humans. Although climate change can also occur from natural causes, human behavior has led to an increase in greenhouse emissions. While climate change is discussed frequently now, it all started during the Industrial Revolution.

After nearly two decades of recording data, NASA has confirmed what it began to suspect in the 90's; the world really is becoming a greener place and two unlikely countries are leading the charge – India and China.

For nearly 20 years NASA has been monitoring the Earth's foliage using two satellites.

Overall, the planet is 5% greener than it was in the early 2000s. They've concluded that humans are behind a large part of this trend. They also discovered something that surprised them; India and China accounted for nearly one-third of the Earth's green.
