

## RECIPE OF VEGETABLE RICE

#### Materials Required:

3tsp oil, I bey leaf, I inch cinnamom, 2 pads of cardamom, ½ onion, I chilli, 5 beans, I carrot, 2 tbsp peas, ½ capsicum, I cup basnati rice, 2 cup of water, I tsp salt, I tsp lemon juice, 2 tbsp, coriander.

#### Procedure:

- I. Firstly, in a large bowl heat 3 tsp oil and soute 1 bay leaf, 1 inch cinnamom, and 2 pads of cardamom until they turn aromatic.
- 2. Now odd 1/2 onion, I chilli and soute them until they turn translucent.
- 3. Further add 5 beans, 1 corrot, 2 thsp-peas, and 1/4 capsicum.
- 4. Stir fry for 2 minutes without mashing the vegetables.
- Now sook I cup of basmati rice in water for 20 minutes, then odd them in the bowl.
- 6. Roast for 2 minutes without breaking the rice.
- 7. Next, add 2 cup of water, I tsp solt and I tsp lemon juice.
- 8. Mix well, cover or simmer for 20 minutes.
- 9. Turn off the flame, cover the bowl and rest for 10 minutes.
- 10. Finally add 2 thsp. of corlander leaves and enjoy your vegetable rice.



## A TOURIST PLACE ELLORA CAVES

The Ellora Caves, a UNESCO World Heritage site, lies 62 miles southwest of Ajanta and are an awe-inspiring example of Indias long and unbroken history. Of the nearby 100 Caves at the site, 34 are open to the public and feature many Buddhists, Hindu and Jain monuments.

The World's largest single monolithic rock excavation, a chariot dedicated to lord Shiva.

All the Ellora monuments were built during Rashtrakutas dynasty, who constructed part of the Hindu and Buddhist Caves and the Yadava dynasty who constructed number of the Jain Caves.

Today, the Ellora Caves, along with the nearby Ajanta Caves, are a major tourist attraction and a protected monument under the Archeological survey of India.

Eleven out of twelve Buddhist Caves consists of viharas or monasteries with 3 large halls, multi storyed building carved into the mountain face, including living quarters, sleeping quarters, kitchens and other rooms. The Monastery Caves have shrines including carvings of Gautama Buddha, bodhisattva sativas and saints. Each year the Caves attract large number of religious pilgrims and tourists. The Annual Ellora Festival of Classical Dance and Music is held there in the third week of March.
